

Quiz

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A 40 year old female presented with a history of slowly progressive skin lesions on her face and neck since the last few years with intermittent acute exacerbations. There was a history of rapid overnight deterioration of skin lesions.

On examination pigmented patches and erosions were seen on her face and neck bilaterally. Post inflammatory hypopigmentation and atrophy was also noticed on her face and sides of neck (Figs.1 & 2). Patient denied having handled the areas affected.
