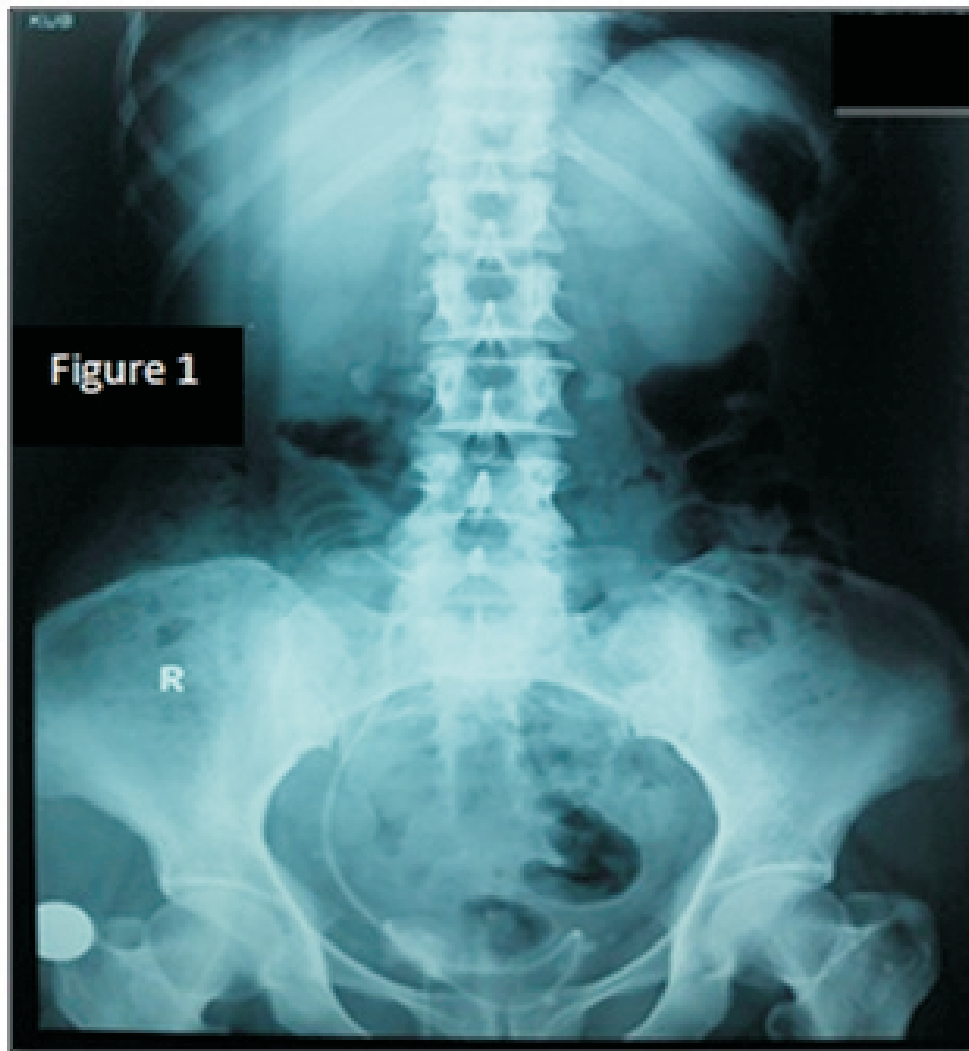


## Quiz
